Bear Creek Community Charter School's charter (contract) with the Wilkes-Barre Area School District requires parents to volunteer at least two hours per month during the school year.

Volunteer hours must be documented by the School, and we have made it easy for parents to document volunteer hours using the Parent Portal. Parents can complete the Volunteer Hours form by selecting Forms, followed by Volunteer Hours Record. These can be found under the Volunteer Program section. These forms should be completed and submitted no later than the 10th day of each month for the prior month's volunteer activities.

Volunteer Requirements: All volunteers must complete and submit a Volunteer Application (found in the Parent Portal) as well as Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Background Check and a Pennsylvania Child Abuse Clearance. Visit the school's website at www.bearcreekschool.com and select "Parents" to learn more about the volunteer application and clearances that are required. If you lived outside the state of Pennsylvania within the past ten years, an FBI Criminal Background Check is also required.
