BENEFITS FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

- ✓ Prepaid accounts for all students allow parents to deposit money in their child's account, in any amount, and at any time, and not have to be concerned with giving their student the exact change every morning.
- ✓ When a student account is prepaid, parents can be sure that students are only using that money for nutritious meals served in the school's cafeteria.
- ✓ Parents can pay any amount at any time. Students can prepay in the lunch line at the cashier, parents can send in checks for deposit, or parents can go online and submit electronic payments.
- ✓ For those students who receive free or reduced priced meals, their meals will be rung up as all the other meals. No one will know whether they are receiving a free or reduced priced meal or debiting their account, except for the cashier.
- ✓ By having money in each child's account prior to entering the cafeteria, we find the lunch lines move along much faster so your child has more time to eat and be with friends.
- ✓ A student's account is only charged for meals that are debited to the student's PIN number. All student PIN numbers are confidential. A PIN pad is located at the end of the lunch line and are easy to use, helping to provide quick transactions.
- ✓ Once the transaction has been completed, the student can obtain his or her account balance.
- ✓ Parents will have the ability to print out a copy of their child's eating history report. This history report will show you all dates and times that your child has purchased a breakfast and or lunch within the past thirty days.
- ✓ Prepayment allows for better security than cash.
- ✓ A student should not go without a complete lunch if they happen to forget their lunch money, as the school will permit up to two complete lunches "on credit" at any given time throughout the year.
- ✓ If a student's lunch account gets low, the system will generate a reminder.
- ✓ Money in the student's account at the end of the school year will be carried over to the next school year
