

Acceptable Proof of Age

Pennsylvania law requires public schools ascertain a child's age at the time of admission. Acceptable documentation acceptable includes any one (1) of the following <u>original</u> documents:

- a. Birth certificate which includes date of birth;
- b. Baptismal certificate which includes date of birth;
- c. Valid United States passport which includes date of birth.

The child's name appearing on these documents will be used for the purpose of all school records. Any deviation from the legal name identified on the document must be verified by a bona fide court document authorizing the legal name change.
