

Volunteer Opportunities

All volunteers are required to complete and return a Volunteer Application, Child Abuse Clearance and Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Background Check. Any volunteer who resided outside of Pennsylvania in the last ten years must also undergo an FBI Criminal Background Check. Most volunteer clearances are free of charge and need to be renewed every five years. More detailed information can be found online:

I understand that, as a Bear Creek Community School volunteer working with children/youth, I am required to obtain a Report of Criminal History from the Pennsylvania State Police and a Child Abuse History Certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services. I understand that if I have not been a resident of Pennsylvania continuously during the past ten years, I am also required to obtain a FBI Federal Criminal History. I further understand that these clearances need to be renewed every 60 months, and that I will not be permitted to serve as a volunteer in contact with children without valid clearances.

I attest that I have never been arrested or convicted of an offense or offenses enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-111€ or (f.1) referred to as "Reportable Offenses", including:

- Section 6318 (relating to unlawful contact with minor)
- Section 6319 (relating to solicitation of minors to traffic drugs)
- Section 6320 (relating to sexual exploitation of children)
- An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act."
- An offense <u>similar in nature</u> to those crimes listed above under the laws or former laws of the United States; or one of its territories or possessions; or another state; or the District of Columbia; or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; or a foreign nation; or under a former law of this Commonwealth.

I have never been convicted of a felony offense under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L., No. 64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act committed within the five-year period immediately preceding volunteer service or request to be considered for volunteer service.

I have never been convicted of the attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit any of the offenses set forth above. I have never been identified as a perpetrator of child abuse in a founded report by a local, county, or state child welfare agency.

I understand that I am required by law to notify the Chief Executive Officer of Bear Creek Community Charter School in writing within 72 hours if I am arrested or convicted of any criminal offense listed above or if I am named as a perpetrator of an indicated or founded child abuse report.

I have requested to provide voluntary service at Bear Creek Community Charter School. I understand that I will not be compensated in any manner and will not be eligible for any employee benefits, including workers' compensation coverage. I declare that I shall hold the Charter School and all its employees harmless from any and all civil liability claims should I be injured while at the Charter School or while providing volunteer service to the Charter School. I understand that I am expected to conform to the School's security, safety and ethical conduct policies, including, but not limited to, the School's policy against sexual and other unlawful harassment. Copies of these policies are available upon request.

I affirm that I am not disqualified from being a school volunteer and the information contained in this Volunteer Application is true and correct. I understand the contents of these statements, and that I am signing it freely and voluntarily.

It is the policy of Bear Creek Community Charter School to provide equal educational, employment, and volunteer opportunities ant not to illegally discriminate on the basis of gender, race, national origin, religion, age, marital status, or disability in its programs, activities, or its policies. Bear Creek Community Charter School reserves the right to restrict or prohibit anyone from volunteer service at any time.
